Calling on students to participate in a theatre performance marking
the 150th Anniversary of the City of Plainfield

Plainfield, NJ. – January 23, 2019 - A second call for student actors, performers, singers and dancers, of all ages and grade levels, was issued by Plainfield Public Schools for the upcoming theatre production marking the 150th Anniversary of the City of Plainfield.

The second round of auditions are scheduled for Saturday, January 26 at 10:00 a.m. at Plainfield High School, 950 Park Avenue.

The play, “Queen City Proud,” written by Keesha Onyx and Danielle Tucker, producers with MPower Productions, will tell the history of Plainfield from its beginning in the 1800s to now.

A cast of approximately 70 performers will be required to accomplish the several scenes that will depict a time-line of Plainfield’s history and its people.
