(Suspend) Caution! Hazard to humans and domestic animals. Harmful if inhaled. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Contact with product may result in transient tingling and reddening of the skin. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use. (ExiteR) NGESTION: May cause gastrointestinal effects, such as nausea, cramps, vomiting and diarrhea. Ingestion of large quantities can result in nervous system effects, such as dizziness, loss of coordination, tremors, and loss of consciousness. Symptoms usually regress with no long-lasting effects. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.
