Plainfield High School opens Career Center for Students

with post-secondary plans and goals.*

Plainfield, NJ – October 10, 2018 – Plainfield High School has added a Career Center for its students at Plainfield High School to prepare for college, future careers and post high school education.

The center is equipped with 25 personal computers, smart boards for presentations, audiovisual equipment and a state-of-the-art software program NAVIANCE to conduct their research.

All students will all have accounts on the software program NAVIANCE, and will use this tool to navigate and prepare for college and careers post-high School.

The Naviance consulting team at Plainfield High School will be assisting the school counselors in the Guidance Department under the Direction of Ms. Denise Shipman.

The counselors will create college and career planning strategies, help the students to define the measurement for academic success and will be working with all Plainfield Public Schools to reach the district's goals to increase the number of students in high school with post-secondary plans and goals.

According to Ms. Shipman, "Naviance also provides professional development training for teachers, counselors, administrators, and hands-on support, so the staff can become proficient with the program."

This service is available to all high school students via their school's Guidance Department.

The College and Career Readiness Center was officially opened at a ribbon-cutting ceremony at Plainfield High School, 950 Park Avenue.
