Plainfield, NJ. – December 11, 2018 - The Plainfield School District is looking for students of all ages, female and male, from elementary to high school grades, to participate in performances being planned to mark the 150th Anniversary of the City of Plainfield.

Students will be able to audition for roles in “Queen City Proud,” a play retelling the history of Plainfield. A cast of approximately 70 performers will be required to accomplish the several skits that will depict a time-line of Plainfield’s history, from its beginnings to the Plainfield we know today.
