The survey is related to the opening of schools for the 2020-2021 School Year

June 3, 2020 - In a letter to parents, the Plainfield Public Schools Superintendent Dr. Diana Mitchell informed parents about the survey issued yesterday by the New Jersey Department of Education.

The survey in English and Spanish includes fourteen questions related to how confident parents feel about sending their children to school in the Fall, wearing masks, transportation, remote learning and access to the internet and access to health and nutrition.
