Point System and Rubric Scoring

The School Self -
Assessments are based
on point system and
rubric scoring with a
maximum of 78 points.

- Does not meet the requirements= 0 points
- Partially meets the requirements=1 point
- Meets all requirement=2 points
- Exceeds the requirements-=3 points



NJDOE UPDATES FOR HIB

- *All districts and schools are required to complete School Self-Assessments to determine a grade under the Anti-Bullying Bill of Right.*
- *The purpose of the School Self-Assessment is to strengthen Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying (HIB) policies, programs and procedure. Note: The Anti-Bullying Specialists and School Safety Teams are responsible for completion of the assessments.*

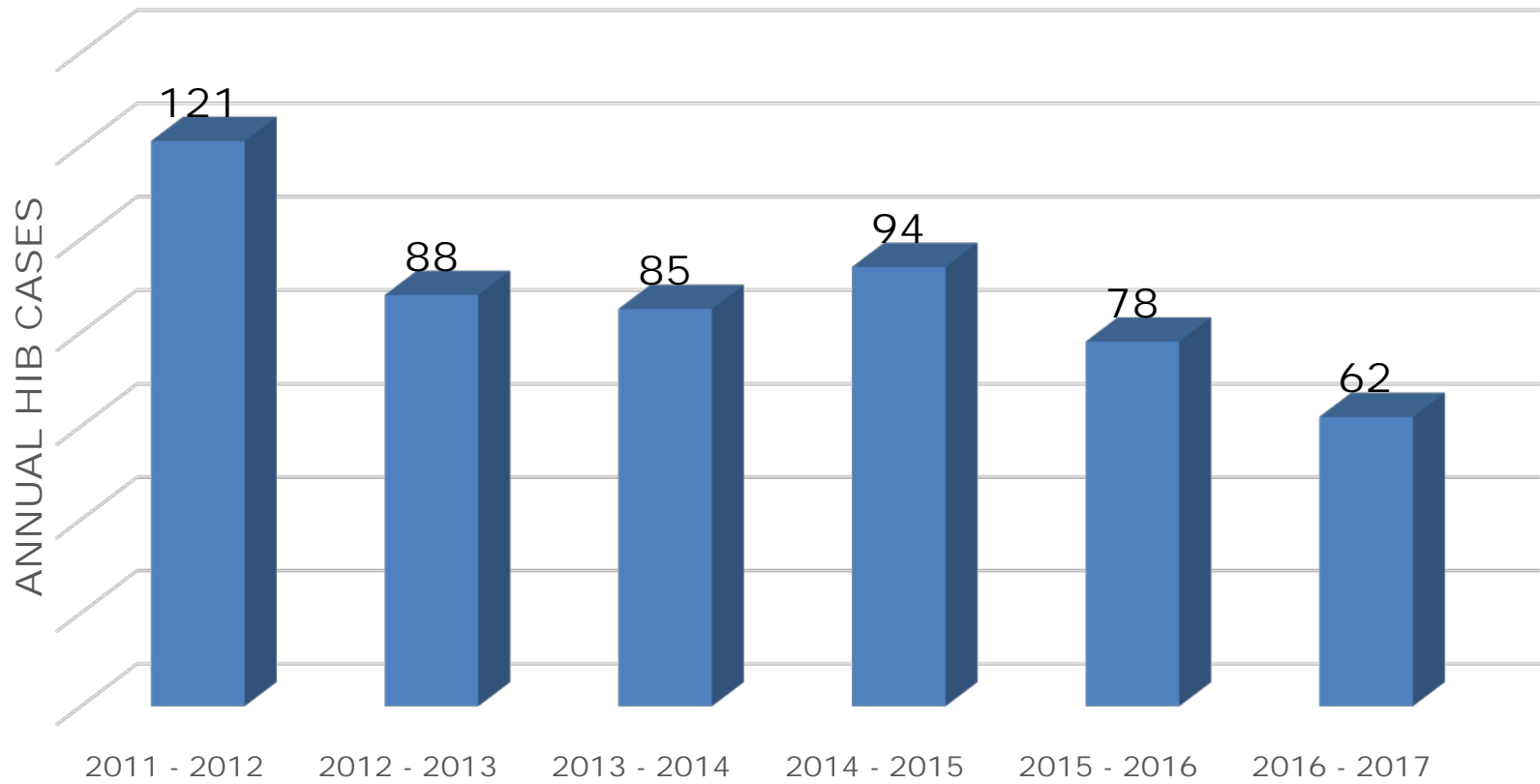
